
## **Voter Distribution across Selected Precincts**

(using 11/3/23 data)



In 2017 precinct 19-10 was divided into 19-19 and 19-18. The following shows for each precinct the number of voters within the Wake Forest and Rolesville municipal corporate boundaries. The remaining voters are in the unincorporated areas of the precincts. For comparison, 19-09 now also serves both Wake Forest (very few voters) with the vast majority of voters being in Rolesville or unincorporated. The red cells show the combined populations for the two municipal areas of a precinct.
